- Infield point of care consultation with specialists

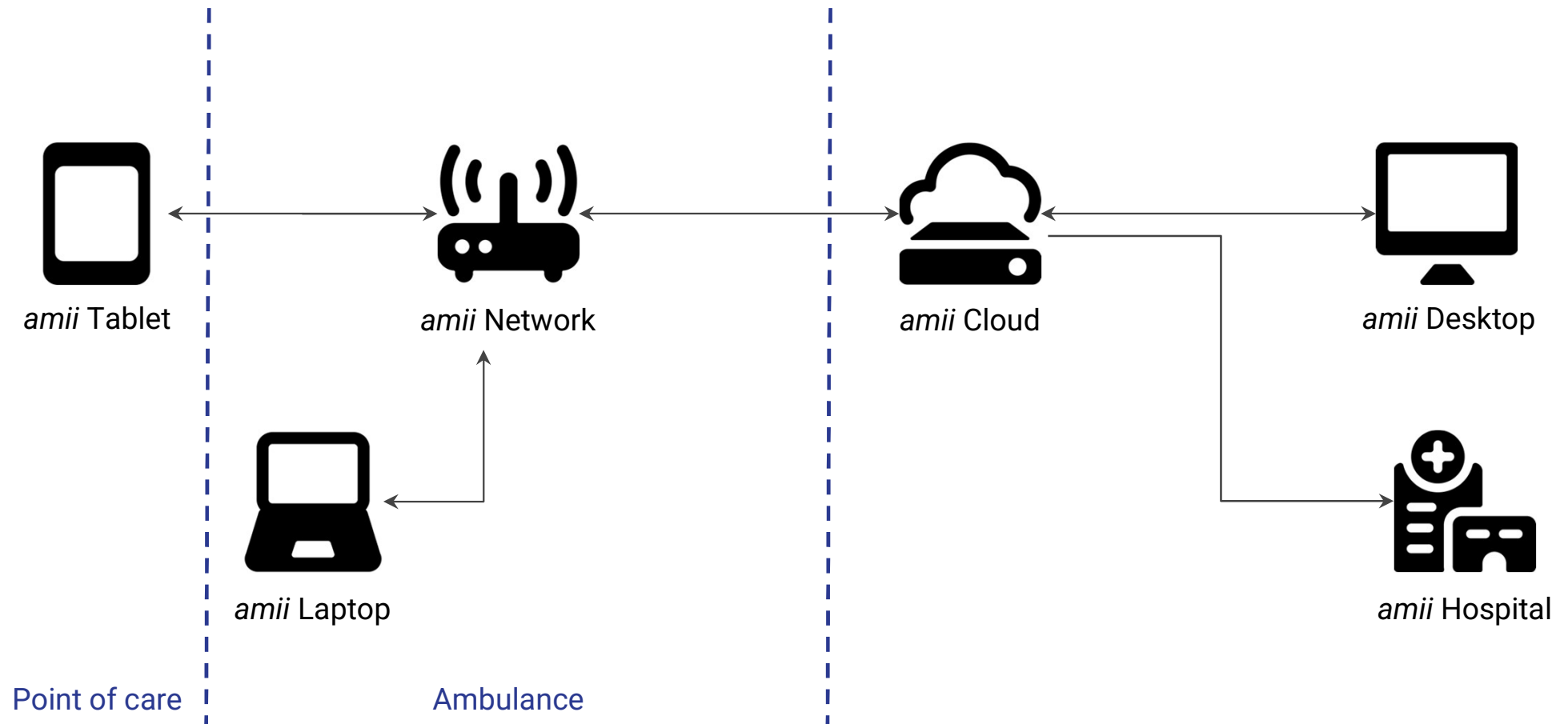


### 3. Improved performance

- Sophisticated AI powered analysis will raise alerts for timely data driven decisions

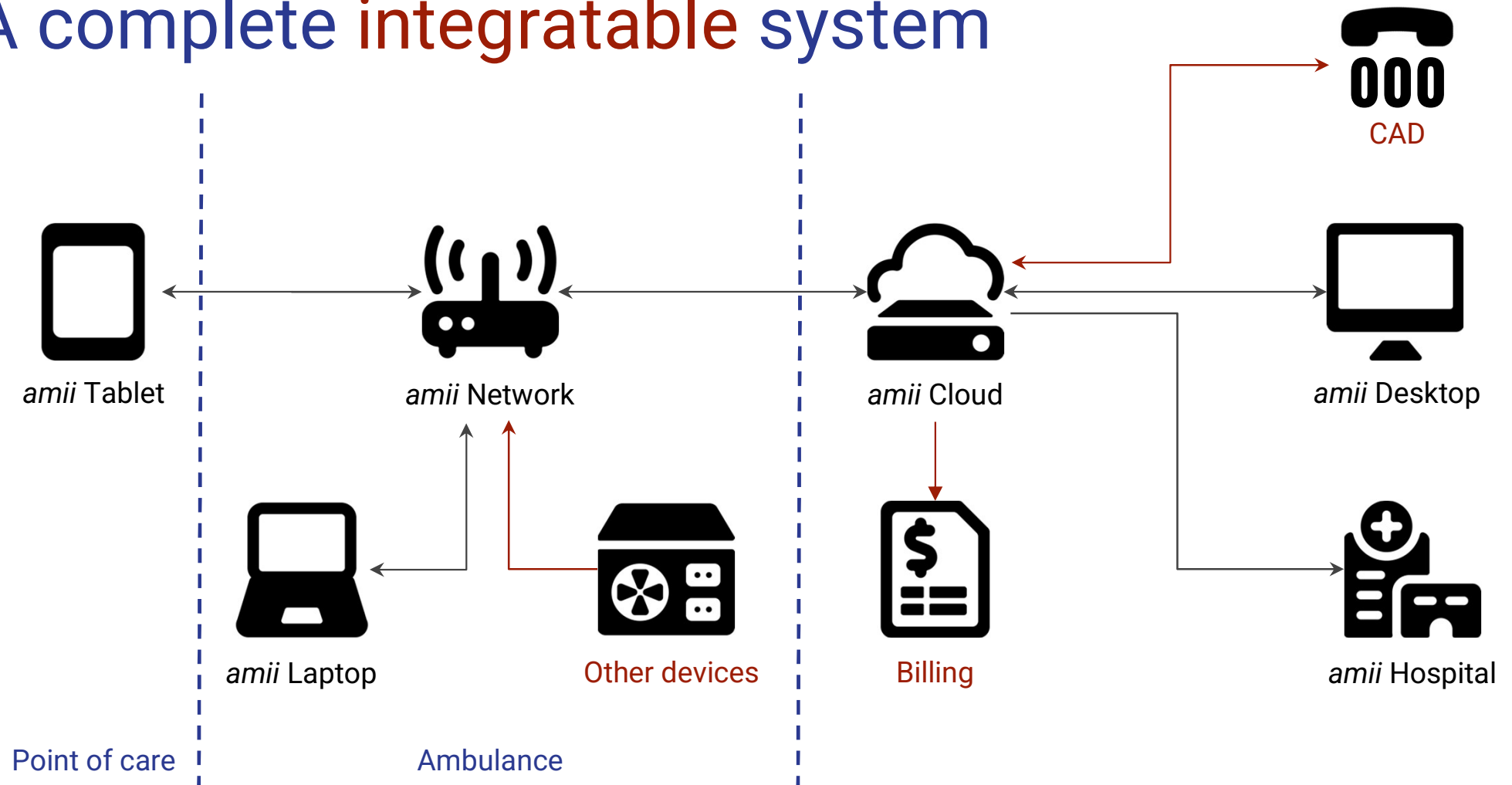
